

Brimbank City Council Agreement and Acknowledgement for a return to activity

This document sets out a range of business and operational actions Council require clubs to undertake and complete prior to recommencement of activities i.e. training only from Friday 11 June. This document is specific to the current State Government Guidelines and COVID Safe Plan to return to play released by State Sporting Association's (SSA), Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and Sport & Recreation Victoria (SRV). Further correspondence will be communicated to clubs once the next update has been provided.

General Action Items

- The Keilor St-Ber4nard's Athletic ClubClub have read, completed and agreed to update their COVID Safe Plan to return to play based on the latest restrictions.
- As part of the ease of restrictions, all clubs will need to adhere to DHHS, SRV and your Governing Body guidelines. Details of this information can be found by clicking on the relevant organisations below:

- When further easing of restrictions are announced, clubs are responsible for updating their COVID Safe Plans.
- The club has kept and will continue to keep in regular contact with their governing body and Brimbank City Council.
- Council can request any documentation at any stage.
- If your club breaches protocol outlined by State Government and Federal Government and/or not implementing your COVID Safe Plan, this may result in the club being suspended from attending its facilities.

Facilities
