

Presidents report 2016-2017.

Throughout the last year we have continued to address numerous issues with the Keilor Park athletics track:

The high jump bag for which the club obtained a grant from the federal government sponsored "Stronger Communities program" is in place and operational at Keilor Park. The delivery and construction of the mobile cover took longer than anticipated because of issues with the supplier but the project is complete and the bag is available for club members and Keilor Little Athletics.

Discussions with the sports and recreation section of Brimbank Council have resulted in plans and costs for the installation of a IAAF standard hammer cage being placed in this years councils sports projects list. The club committee has agreed to contribute towards the costs.

The addition of a pole vault facility is being investigated. There are substantial costs, the basic bag and support poles, bars and measuring equipment plus a mobile cover and some concrete work to support the cover.

The club is in the process of acquiring some used "competition level" hurdles from Athletics Essendon. These hurdles are old and heavy but are in good condition and are available at quite moderate cost.

Some thought has been given to the construction of adjustable size steeples for the steeple-chase.

Brimbank councils is now operated by elected council members rather than administrators appointed by the state government. Attempts are under-way to get to know Keilor Park ward councillors and make them aware of the Keilor Park athletics track.

Once again considerable time and effort was spent on Athletics Victoria's "Club Connect" requirements for the club to have policies and plans and documentation for just about everything. Policies have been created for "inclusion" and "policies" as have plans addressing "risk", "communications" and "volunteers". A members handbook, uniform information document and lists of committee and coaches have been created. All required documentation has been supplied to Athletics Victoria and appropriate documents will be made available through the clubs web site (www.ksbaths.org.au >about us>policies).

In January and February club members and coaches provided "advanced coaching" services to Keilor Little athletics members who were participating in the Little Athletics Victoria regional and state championships. This was successful and should make the club visible to a larger number of Keilor Little athletes and their parents.

The end of the summer track and field season was marked by the club handicap early in March with the following members being successful, men's 110 metres Laz Sarris, men's 1600 Thomas Kennedy, women's 110 and 800 Georgia Stepanoski.

A number of our athletes have been training for the pole vault at Melbourne University. The sports control organisation at the university now requires that anyone who uses university facilities be a member of a university team. To retain our athletes we are currently negotiating with Athletics Essendon for use of the PV facility at Aberfeldie and some means of providing and sharing coaches.

This year saw a substantial drop in the clubs membership following steady increases in recent years. Some of this may be related to the new system of membership and participation fees introduced by Athletics Victoria where athletes can elect to participate in either winter or summer competition (or only championships or relays), the move of winter races to venues on the other side of Melbourne and the shift of the majority of "Shield" competition to before Christmas where it conflicts with examinations and seasonal activities may be other factors. We are also in an era of increased competition with other sports, men's football training over summer and now women's football. Experience has shown that advertising and recruiting can be time consuming and generally results in little return on the effort involved. Hopefully the traditional word of mouth and increased numbers from Keilor Little athletics will improve numbers in coming years.

The club continues to meet its commitments and obligations to support the conduct of Athletics Victoria events during the winter XCR and the summer Track&Field. We consistently supply officials where and when required. Thanks to all those who have helped.

I would like to thank all athletes and parents who helped in any way and the members of the committee for their efforts over the last year. Than you!

A number of the committee are stepping down and I would like to thank them for their efforts over the last years.

Coaches Report Season 2016/17

The main highlight of this season has been the efforts of the under 20 men in both the cross country season and the track season. The cross-country team consisting of Damien Hughes, Jai Keighery, Patrick Matthews, Alexander Sykes and Shea Wellington gained places in both the schools competition and Club competitions.

They were joined in the summer by Sam Charville, Michael Giancola, Riley Caines Domenic Miesen, Tim Petersen and successfully won the Yellow Zone Premiership followed by the State Shield Premiership.

Their strength showed when Damien Hughes, Patrick Matthews Alexander Sykes Shea Wellington, Michael Giancola, Riley Caines, and Tim Petersen all gained entry standards for the National Championships. In the championships Michael Giancola made the final of the 100m and was selected in the Victorian team for the 4 x 100 relay, which gained him a silver medal.

Jayden Ristevski also qualified for the open 400m hurdles at the Nationals.

Wilson Cram finished 2nd on a count back in the national under 15 pole vault and Elias Khasay made the final of the under 14 400 and 800 finishing 4th in the 400m.

The women were also well represented at the nationals with Kate Abfalter finishing 3rd in the under 20 pole Vault and also competed in the under 20 steeple. Millie Cram competed in the under 17 heptathlon finishing 7th in a very competitive and produced several personal best performances and finished 1st in the 800m the final event of the competition. Kara Olsen finished 7th in the high jump and Ellie Keratianos ran very well in her heat of the 100m but missed the final.

Kate Abfalter has been selected in the Australian under 20 team to compete in the Oceania Games in Fiji in June. She will be competing in the Pole Vault and the 3000m steeple. Michael Giancola missed selection by one place.

The Shield competition saw our 40 plus men, 40 plus women, under 20 women, under 18 women and under 14 women finish as runners up for the season so they all proceeded to the Shield final where the under 18 girls were the most successful finishing 3rd of 11 teams.

The Club gift was a very successful night both on the track and socially with Georgia Stepanoski showing marked improvement to

win both the 100m and 800m in the women's events. Laz Sarris also found a yard to win the sprint and Tom Kennedy showed a clean pair of heels to the field as he won the 1600m.

No season can go without a lot of help and I would like to thank the following people who were particularly helpful to me throughout the year Rebecca Stepanowski ,Janaka Egodawatte, Krystal Kunig and my wife Anne. David Long (Preston) also during the winter season.

I would like to thank my fellow coaches, Randy, Cathie, Ian, Maria, Anne, Emma, Russell and John K who helped out in various facets of coaching including the work we did with Keilor Little Athletes during the year.

I would also like to welcome our new coaches in recently qualified Alexandra Sykes and Patrick Matthews.
